## Watercolor Landscape

This class will cover using watercolor to create dynamic and luminous landscapes. We will work from photographs of the local area, including our Elk Grove parks and from student's photo references. Demonstrations will include composing the space, value and color masses, approaches for natural plant life including texture, specialty brushes, salt and alcohol techniques. We will look at photos and explore depicting a variety of weather types including strong light, deep twilight, snow, and rain. During the last hour of the class, students will work from a photo to develop their own landscape. Supply list is available online.
